BC Soccer Primer League (BCSPL) Age Group Changes 2023+

Background

The BC Soccer Premier League (BCSPL) was established in 2010 as a standards-based development environment for girls and boys aged U13 to U18. It is positioned as the highest level of youth development community soccer within BC. Its purpose is to bring together identified players from the BC Soccer membership in training and game environments to support overall development. As well as providing further opportunities for player identification into higher levels of play including, BC Soccer Provincial Programming, University, League 1 BC, Professional, and National teams programming and progressing into adult community soccer.

The BCSPL is also designed to support the development of coaches and referees, who are required to attain a minimum level of certification to ensure high standards are in place. This is complimented with ongoing technical support through the BCSPL Participating Clubs, BC Soccer, and Canada Soccer.

Annual Review

On an annual basis, BC Soccer through a consultation process gathers formal feedback on the BCSPL, its Rules & Regulations, and technical standards in two ways:

- 1) through the BCSPL club feedback survey, and
- 2) through individual club meetings conducted by the BCSPL General Manager.

The purpose of the consultation process is to provide an opportunity for all BCSPL Club Leadership to share feedback on the previous year's BCSPL experience with the intent to support BC Soccer on shaping the BCSPL for following year's implementation and beyond. In addition to the consultation process with the BCSPL clubs, BC Soccer works with Canada Soccer and its Technical Department in further aligning the BCSPL Rules & Regulations (technical standards) with the Canada Soccer Player Development Program standards and/or to meet specific Provincial needs.

From this year's consultation process there were two key outcomes that will impact what the BCSPL will look like from September 2023 and beyond, which include:

- *The New Intake Age Group of the BCSPL will be the U14 Intake (2011 Birth Year) for September 2024*
- *The New Exit Age Group of the BCSPL will be the U17 age group (2007 Birth Year) for 2024 onwards*

We understand that these changes directly impact players, parents, and coaches, therefore for more information on the rationale support the changes to the BCSPL, please see the following FAQs provided.

The New Exit Age Group of the BCSPL will be the U17 age group (2007 Birth Year) for 2024 onwards

Commencing Spring 2024, the U18 age group will be phased out of the BCSPL. The last year of participation will be Phase 1 of 2024 (2006 Birth Year).

In 2024 the new exit age group of the BCSPL will be the U17 age group (2007 Birth Year). This means the U17 age group will only play in Phase 1 in 2024 completing their participation with Provincial Championships in June 2024.

Why is BC Soccer making this change?

There are many reasons why this change is being implemented, including:

- Aligning to Canada Soccer
- Providing opportunity for progressive players (University identified/committed) to experience adult soccer environments at the U18+ age group to further support their development.
- Providing opportunity for more community/recreational players to play within the U18 youth community/recreational playing environments.
- Supporting the transition of youth to adult soccer in the various playing environments provided.
- Allowing BCSPL clubs to focus on a core age range of players from U14 to U17 age groups.
- Considering the financial cost to the parent and aims to remove this.

Who does this change impact?

In the first instance, the 2007 birth year group of players are impacted as well as future birth years with the BCSPL ending at the U17 age group after the (Provincial and National Cup Competitions) in the middle of 2024 and beyond.

What does this change mean for the 2007 Birth Year player?

For the 2007 birth year group it means that their last year of participation in the BCSPL will be Phase 1 of 2024.

When and how will this be implemented?
