



## 2023 Pick Up Player Agreement Form

The BC SPL is no longer requiring game by game permits signed by district reps. As you are pulling players from the coastal season (Aug-July), you need a new form signed by the club partner only once from August through July each season.

For a BC SPL club to pick up a player registered outside of their club, this is the process:

- 1) BC SPL club signs this season-long pick up player agreement, along with the releasing club doing the same
- 2) BC SPL club advises the releasing club's TD of intent to pick up the player, and completes the online [pick up form](#) with player name/club/birthdate that they are picking up. They will submit that form and receive a PDF copy that they should email to the releasing club's TD as confirmation of the player pick up
- 3) Player plays the game with their ID card, and BC SPL club provides printed guest player form to match official with all players added pre-printed or hand-written onto the game sheet

---

The BC SPL club may pick up a player for multiple reasons, however the over-arching reason is for player development, and to provide players with opportunities.

BC SPL clubs are responsible for ensuring proper game to training ratios of all their players, including pick up players. Also, BC SPL clubs will ensure no conflicts exist with the pick up player's club. For example, the BC SPL club will ensure there is enough time between games, or that games take place on different days, so that a pick up player will not have to choose between games. In all instances, the BC SPL club will put the player first in all pick up procedures.

By signing this agreement, the BC SPL club and releasing club agree to the above for the period from 8/1/2022 to 7/1/2023
